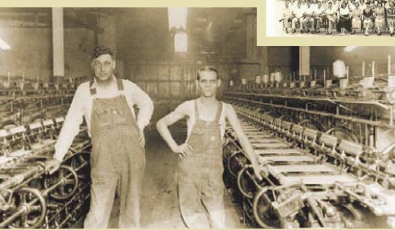


# West Georgia Textile Heritage Trail

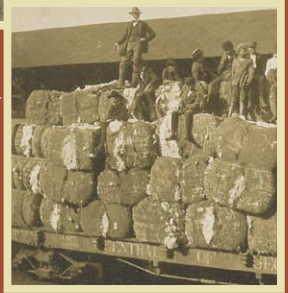
# West Georgia Textile Heritage Trail
